REGULATIONS

- 1 RSAC Motorsport Limited, in association with Monte Start Committee (MSC Scotland) will promote a touring assembly on Saturday 20 January 2018 under a Certificate of Exemption 105109, issued by the Motor Sports Association.
- 2 The event is open to all classic car enthusiasts. Competing cars will be divided into the following classes:
 - (a) Sporting Cars of any age
 - (b) Other cars permitted at the discretion of the Organisers
- 3 The events will start from the Winnock Hotel, Drymen with the first car leaving at 1900 on Saturday 20 January 2018 and finish at Loch Lomond Arms Hotel, Main Road, Luss.
- 4 Signing On will take place from 1800 on Saturday 20 January 2018 at the Winnock Hotel where a light supper will be served prior to the start. Individual start times will be issued with the Final Instructions. Cars will start at one minute intervals.

Entrants will be required to sign a declaration stating they have the following where required by law.

A valid MOT Certificate

Vehicle Excise Duty paid

A minimum of Third Party Insurance for all persons who will drive the participating vehicles must be applicable for the duration of the event.

- 5 The route will consist of 47 miles on public A and B Class and unclassified roads which will all be on sealed surfaces. Details of the route will be sent out prior to the event in a "Monte" style itinerary to allow navigators to plot the route on their maps.
- 6 The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and entry form, closing on Monday 15 January 2018. Refunds for withdrawn entries will be at the discretion of the organisers. Cars may only carry the number of passengers permitted by the seating accommodation.

The entry fee for the event is £25, which will include a rally plate, competition numbers, other necessary documents and a light supper prior to the start. All entries must be made on the entry form, accompanied by the appropriate fee, enclosed as a cheque or postal order. Cheques should be made payable to Monte Start Committee Scotland. No e-mail entries will be accepted.
