The Aberdeen run will start on the morning of 31 January and will join the other participants at Paisley Abbey.

REGULATIONS

- 1 Cumberland Sporting Car Club Limited, in association with Monte Start Committee (MSC Scotland) will promote a touring assembly on Wednesday 31 January 2018 under a Certificate of Exemption 104199, issued by the Motor Sports Association.
- 2 The event is open to all classic car enthusiasts. Competing cars will be divided into the following classes:
 - (a) Cars manufactured up to 1981
 - (b) Cars of a later date that were in production during the period stated above.
 - (c) Other cars permitted at the discretion of the Organisers
- 3 The events will start from Aberdeen on the morning of 31 January 2018 and from the start ramp at Paisley Abbey in the evening, following the departure of the Rallye Monte Carlo Historique and Classique cars.
- 4 Signing On locations will be issued with the Final Instructions. Cars will start at one minute intervals. Individual start times will be in the Final Instructions.

Entrants will be required to sign a declaration stating they have the following where required by law.

A valid MOT Certificate

Vehicle Excise Duty paid

A minimum of Third Party Insurance for all persons who will drive the participating vehicles must be applicable for the duration of the event.

5 The routes will be on public A and B Class and unclassified roads and will all be on sealed surfaces. A tulip road book will be supplied at documentation and signing on prior to the start.

6 The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and entry form, closing on Wednesday 24 January 2018. Refunds for withdrawn entries will be at the discretion of the organisers. Cars may only carry the number of passengers permitted by the seating accommodation.

The entry fee for the event is £29, which includes a tulip road book, rally plates, souvenir programme and refreshments prior to the start at Paisley. All entries must be made on the entry form, accompanied by the appropriate fee, enclosed as a cheque or postal order. Cheques should be made payable to Monte Start Committee Scotland. No e-mail entries will be accepted.
