REGULATIONS

- 1 RSAC Motorsport Ltd in association with Monte Start Committee (MSC Scotland) will promote a touring assembly – Jock's Run, (An Ayrshire Amble) – on Sunday 18 June 2017 under a Certificate of Exemption 102159, issued by the Motor Sports Association.
- 2 The event is open to all car enthusiasts. Competing cars will be divided into the following classes.
 - (a) Cars manufactured before 1980
 - (b) Sporting cars of any age
 - (c) Other cars permitted at the discretion of the Organisers
- 3 The event will start and finish at the Morris Equestrian Centre, on the B751 Kilmaurs Road, just off the M77, west of Fenwick, Ayrshire

- 4 Signing on will take place at Morris Equestrian Centre from 08.30. The first car will leave at 10.00. Cars will start at one minute intervals. Individual start times will be in the final instructions.

Entrants will be required to sign a declaration stating they have the following, where required by law:

A valid Mot Certificate

A valid Road Fund Licence

A minimum of Third Party Insurance for all persons who will drive the participating vehicles must be applicable for the duration of the event

- 5 The route will be on public A and B Class and unclassified roads and will all be on sealed surfaces. A tulip road book will be supplied after documentation and signing on prior to the start.

- 6 The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and entry form, closing on Saturday 10 June 2017. Refunds for withdrawn entries will be at the discretion of the organisers. Cars may only carry the number of passengers permitted by the seating accommodation.

The entry fee for the event is £39 which includes a Tulip Road Book, rally plate and a two course evening meal for two persons at the finish. Additional meals may be added on the entry form. All entries must be made on the entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee, enclosed as a cheque or postal order. Cheques should be made payable to MSC Scotland

The maximum number of entries is 60 which will be accepted in order of receipt. No e-mail entries will be accepted.
