EXCITING NEW FORMAT FOR CLASSIQUE 2021

The Start venue will be Banbury. Here is the proposed itinerary.

Sat 30 Jan 2021	Event administration – numbers, rally plates etc.
Sat 30 Jan 2021	Rally Start from Start Ramp at Banbury Town Hall. Time tbc
Sat 30 Jan 2021	Route through UK and on into France via Ferry/Tunnel (at own expense.)
Sat 30 Jan 2021	Overnight halt in France – venue tbc, paid by MSC
Sun 31 Jan 2021	Continue journey to Valence – first overnight accommodation in Valence at own expense.
Mon 1 Feb 2021	Departure from Valence Monday February 1 st around noon after the Rallye Monte Carlo Historique and then the same itinerary as the Rallye Monte Carlo Historique as well as the ZRs.
Mon 1 Feb 2021	Second overnight stay in Valence at IBIS STYLES Hotel – included in cost of Rallye, booked by ACM.
Tues 2 Feb 2021	Departure from Valence around 10h30 after the Rallye Monte Carlo Historique with a different itinerary from the Rallye Monte Carlo Historique.
Tues 2 Feb 2021	Arrive in Monaco before 20h00 for a podium finish.
Tues 2 Feb 2021	Buffet in the tent on the quay adjacent to parc fermé with Historique crews.
